










(a) TYPES OF BURIAL-POTS OF STRATUM I WITH THEIR COVERS.






PAINTED SHERDS FROM MOUNDS TYPICAL OF BURIAL POTTERY.








FIG. 1. BEADS OF AGATE.




FIG. 2. BEADS OF CARNELIAN.





FIG. 6. BEADS OF LIMESTONE & STALAGMITE.




FIG. 1. BEADS OF NATURAL STEATITE.




FIG. 2. ZONE BEADS OF BURNT STEATITE.




FIG. 1. SPACING BEADS OF BURNT STEATITE.



FIG. 4. CROSS, STEP & TOOTH BEADS OF BURNT STEATITE.




FIG. 5. BEADS OF BURNT STEATITE.




FIG. 1. DISC BEADS OF "BURNED" STEATITE.




FIG. 2. PAINTED STEATITE BEADS.




FIG. 3. FAIENCE SPACING BEADS WITH MIDDLE RIB.




FIG. 4. FAIENCE SPACING BEADS.




FIG. 5. BLACK FAIENCE BEADS.




FIG. 6. WHITE FAIENCE BEADS.




FIG. 7. YELLOW FAIENCE BEADS.




FIG. 8. VARIEGATED FAIENCE BEADS.






FIG. 9. FAIENCE BEADS—MOSTLY BLUE OR GREEN.




FIG. 1. BEADS OF TERRACOTTA OR POTTERY.




FIG. 2. BEADS OF SHELL.




FIG. 7. GOLD BEADS.



MOHENJO-DARO.



SEAL FROM HARAPPA.



SECTION OF "BURNED" STEATITE BEAD FROM HARAPPA.



SECTION OF "BURNED" STEATITE BEAD FROM UR.



FROM HARAPPA.









- b. POLARIZED LIGHT.







SECTION OF VERY HARD FINE GRAINED FAIENCE SOMETIMES CALLED VITREOUS PASTE.

- b. POLARIZED LIGHT.





