# SUGGESTIONS TO THE COORDINATOR FOR HOW TO CLEAN YOUR WORK PLACE (They may give their inputs also)

- 1. Beautify the area where people used to throw the garbage, this will refrain people from throwing garbage at that place again.
- 2. Waste must be segregated properly in different bins.
  - 3. Put waste paper baskets in every room and a big one outside near the Division/Area with USE ME marked prominently.
  - 4. Chewing of pan in all offices should be banned.
  - 5. Every employee should be made responsible for keeping his/her desk clean.
  - 6. Dust-bins should be imaginatively and attractively designed, in bright colours, with suitable inscription on them (without spending IGNCA's money).
  - 7. Team members to speak at all levels must make it a point to speak about it, and set personal examples not just tokens, at all possible occasions (Like we do for publicising our programmes and website).
  - 8. If we see anything(paper, plastic, banana leaf etc.) lying on floor, pick it and throw them in dust bin.
  - 9. A small sub group (5 employees) may be constituted which will monitor and educate people in the office premises.
  - 10. Each individual responsible for at least one area assigned by Co-ordinator.
  - 11.Co-ordinators must ensure that waste disposal mechanism is in place.
  - 12. Encourage your team members to reach 10 minutes ahead of time and clean up our own work place / work bench.
  - 13.Co-ordinators ensure that instead offices' washrooms have hand driers in working condition.
  - 14. An 'Office Cleanliness Manual' should be created with inputs from all the coordinators and induction of every new employee.





- 15.Co-ordinators talk of Waste printed A4 sheets be used as rough papers for notes on the back side.
- 16.A poster campaign should be done in office telling people about the pros and cons of keeping their workplace clean. All the groups may create one poster each. We have talented young scholars, designers and CIL who can contribute in making posters on computer and then IGNCA may think of printing these posters. Cost of printing of 10 posters (10 groups would be formed should not be more than Rs. 20,000/-) Or we can have a poster campaign throughout the month with each month responsibilty would be of one group.
