ARCHITECTURAL STYLE Ornamentation		
Exteriors	:	The vimana has five horizontal bands and decorate with a number of stucco figures such as - monkey, bu elephant, divinities like Hanuman. The erotic image and Dasanana Ravana are the major attraction of th temple. Udyotasimhas are represented at gan portion on each raha paga and dopichhasimhas ov the beki. The jagamohana has a series of pilast designs.
Interiors	:	The rear wall of the <i>vimana</i> is painted with paintings Nataraja, <i>Dikpalas</i> such as Agni, Vayu, Indra ar figures of Narada, Brahma, lord Krisna and dancir <i>nayikas</i> .
Movable Collections	:	Amalaka, Udyotasimhas and an image of the fema devotee.
* Any Other (specify)	:	It is <i>pancharatha</i> on plan and stands over a hig platform measuring 0.65 mtrs in height. A circular we having a diameter of 2.00 mtrs made of khandoli stone is noticed on the north- east corner of the temple.
