Urban setting
Stand in isolation Street Integral part of a landscape / Street / Complex :
16.10 mtrs x 5.35 mtrs x 10.33 mtrs (m / cm/ feet / inch)

Facing towards east. The temple has a square <i>vimana, jagamaohana</i> and an additional rectangular <i>natamandira</i> which stands on a <i>pista</i> (platform) of 0.87 mtrs in height.
Decorated with mythical animals like <i>Gajavyala</i> , secular images, <i>nayikas</i> , erotic figures and architectural motifs like – miniature <i>rekha deulas</i> . Decorated with paintings of <i>Dasamahavidyas</i> on the inner wall of the <i>natamandira</i> .
Nil The temple is <i>pancharatha</i> on plan and <i>panchangabada</i> in elevation.
The <i>vimana</i> is a <i>rekha deula</i> while the <i>jagamohana</i> is <i>pidha deula</i> of <i>Kalingan</i> order. Ashlar dry masonry Gray sand stone is used for the temple construction
and laterite for foundation.

Water percolates inside the *sanctum* through the cracks developed in the roof of the *vimana* and *jagamohana* and growth of vegetation like creepers and pipal trees in the *beki* endangered the monument.
