The god is standing on a lotus pedestal, holding wheel, conch, mace in his upper right, upper left and lower left hand respectively. The lower right hand is in varadamudra. Trefoil arch behind the deity, flying vidyadhara at the top, two female attendants holding lotus stalk on the sides and a female devotee at the foot.
