Exteriors : The conjunction between the *pages* of the *vimana* and

the jagamohana are housed with sculptural pieces such as gaja-vidalas in the talajangha whereas nayikas like- Alasakanya, chauri- bearer, etc and maithuna images in different posture in the upper jangha. The gandi is adorned with gajakranta in each raha and dopichhasimhas and deulacharinis over the

beki.
