architectural motifs like *khakharamundis* and *pidhamundis* on the walls of the *jagamohana*. The doorjambs contain two fierce looking *dvarapalas* at the base. Each door keeper holds a staff in one hand and

shows abhaya mudra in the other hand.

Interiors : The interior of the *jagamohana* is plain.

Movable Collections : Two chlorite image of Varaha and Trivikrama, and a

broken image of Narasimha, etc.
