LAGIOIS	are hidden. Parsvadevata niches are surmounted by urdhagarvika in khakhara mundi designs. At the base of the gandi, there is a miniature rekha angasikhara in the western wall surmounted by an udyota- simha standing over a human head. In the beki, dopichha simhas are noticed above the kanika pagas and deula charini above the raha of four sides. In the kanika paga diminutives female figures are noticed.
