Ornamentation

Exteriors : The monastery is devoid of ornamentation. The

temple within the monastery is decorated with various religious diminutive motifs in the clerestory of receding recess. Three *udyota simaha* occupy in the central tier right above the doorjambs on three sides. The *Kalasa* is flanked by two *udyota simhas* facing towards the opposite direction. The southern *raha* niche houses a two armed Hanuman image. The doorjambs are carved with thee plain vertical

bands.
