the Kanika paga and deulacharinis at the center of the beki, the parsvadevata niches enshrined a fourarmed standing image of Karitkeya, Uma-mahesvara murthy and a six-armed Ganesa on the western, eastern and southern side respectively; two saivite dvarapalas at the base of the doorjambs and

navagraha panel in the architrave.
