Construction Technology	: : : : : : : : : : : : : : : : : : : :	Externally the <i>matha</i> has no decorative features except the doorjambs which are carved with four <i>sakhas</i> or naga-nagi, <i>puspa</i> , <i>naras</i> and <i>lata</i> . At the lalatabimb there is a Gahalaxmi image seated in lotus pedestal. At the base of the doorjambs there is <i>khakhara mundi</i> the enshrine male attendants within the niches. The doorjambs have been extensively carved with cult icon and <i>nayika</i> images. The jambs have been segmente like <i>Panchangabada</i> with Naga and Yamuna on left an right jambs respectively. Plain Nil This is the oldest Manastery of puri with a great antiquity
