**Exteriors** The total jangha of the vimana is decorated with

series of khakhara mundis where as upara jangha is decorated with pidha mundis. The conjunctions are carved with Vyala figures in upper part and Navika figures in lower part. River goddess Ganga & Yamuna are noticed on either side of the door frame of *jagamohana* standing over their respective mounts and holding usual attributes. The doorjambs are decorated with scroll works like Lata & Nara Sakha. The parsvadevata niches enshrine deities like Anjana in eastern, yama in western niche & Vayu in the northern niches. In the architrave of the

vimana thre is a navagraha panel.
