Ornamentation Exteriors	:	The doorjambs are carved with two vertical bands of scroll works of naga sakha and puspa sakha from interior to exterior. At the base of the door jambs there are dvarapala niches on either sides that enshrines be female dvarapalika. They are holdings sword in right hand and severed head in left hand. At the lalatabimbe there is a Gajalaxmi in padmasana sitting over a loture pedestal. The architrave above the doorjambs has the navagraha panel.
