ARCHITECTURAL STYLE

Ornamentation

Exteriors : The northern *raha* niche enshrines the image of a four

armed *Trivikrama* standing over a lotus pedestal. The southern niches enshrined the image of four armed *Varaha* standing over a lotus pedestal. The eastern niches houses the image of a four armed Vishnu standing over a lotus pedestal. The western wall is carved with a miniature *rekha angasikhara* surmounted by a *gajakranta*. There are divine figures right above the *raha* at *beki*. The doorjambs of the *vimana* are carved with two vertical bands. In the *lalatabimba*, there is a Gajalaxmi image seated over a lotus pedestal in *lalitasana*. At the base of the doorjambs there are two *Khakhara mundis* on either side, that house the four armed vaisnavite *dvarapala* holding attributes of lord

Vishnu.
