The main spire Public square Bridge has curvilinear shikhara with two Park or garden Tunnel shikhra on the either side. The Other engineering structure Gravevard entrance to the temple is through Baolis, Well a door fitted with iron-grills. The Tank door lintel and 'Dvar-shakas' are Cave adorned with beautiful pattern.

The interior of the temple is embellished with ornamented pillars. Black and white marble tiles have been used for flooring towards the 'Garbha griha'. 'Dvarpalas' are at the entrance of the 'Garbha-griha'. A stone image of shivlingam placed inside the sanctum and a Nandi seated towards it.
