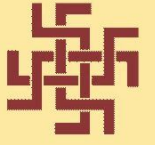

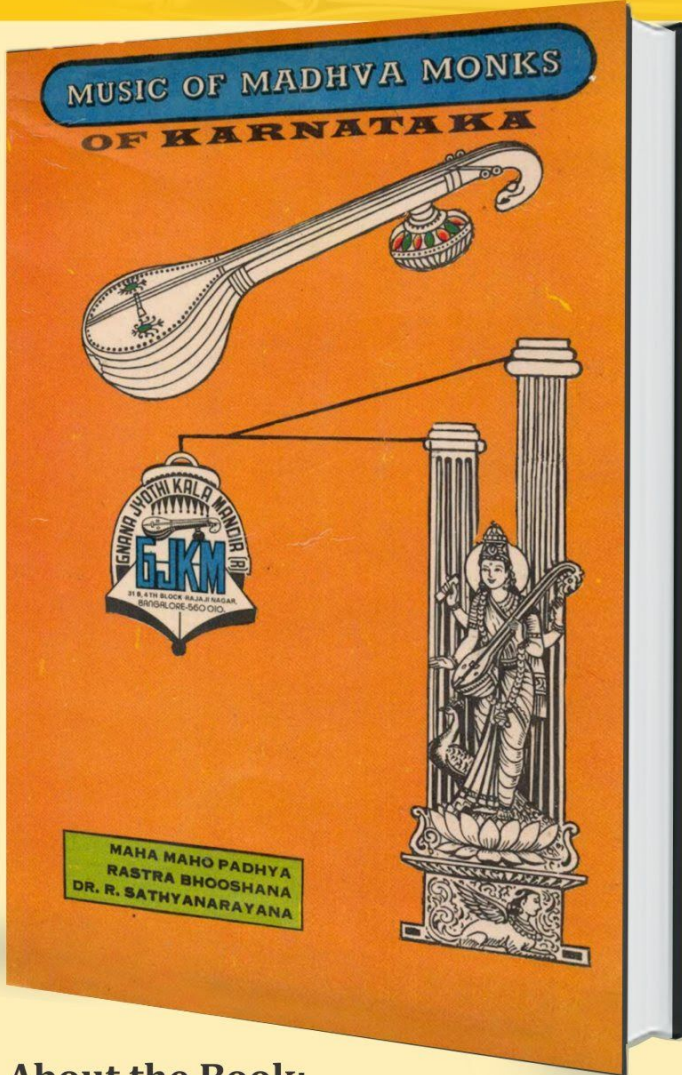

About the Book:

'Music of the Mādhva Monks' by Prof. Dr. R. Sathyanarayana is a pioneering study of the musical contribution of five monks belonging to the Mādhva faith viz. Śrīpādarāya, Vyāsarāya, Vādirāja, Vijayīndra Tīrtha and Rāghavendra Tīrtha to South Indian Music. Śrīpādarāya inaugurated many new musical forms which served as archetypes or prototypes. Vyāsarāya was a Vāggēyakāra who became a bridge between lakṣya and lakṣaṇa. He was the guru of Purandara Dāsa who is widely venerated because of his musical contributions. Vijayīndra Tīrtha, Vyāsarāya's disciple, was also a composer. Another of Vyāsarāya's disciples, Vādirāja was the most prolific and varied composer among the monks. The book is the first of its kind in material and treatment.
