




country and aborad. It should help them to relish that teste of various dimensions of Indian Aesthetics.



Bhartrhari's *Vākyapadīya* occupies a central place in the Indian Philosophy of language. In order to grasp the real impart of the issues discussed in different schools of Indian philosophy and their methodology it is essential to study the *Vākyapadīya*, as it reflects the development of the philosophy of language, theories of meaning, the relationship between language and reality in Indian tradition. Recognising the fact that Bhartrhari's *Vākyapadīya* had engaged the attention of thinkers of different schools of Indian Philosophy, the IGNCA, Varanasi organised a series of seminars on the Vakyapadiya of Bhartrhari. The present volume is an outcome of the seminar held at Varanasi in February 2011.

It is hoped that this volume will be of immense interest to the philosophers of language across countries. It should help them to explore and understand some of the intricate aspects of Bhartrhari's philosophy of language and compare it with the terminology and technique developed by modern Western thinkers.
