Guwahati: The Indira Gandhi National Centre for Arts, regional centre, Bangalore, in collaboration with the North Eastern Regional Centre, Guwahati, is organising Dakshin Spoorthi, which is a part of the Northeast cultural exchange programme, here and in Imphal.

Under this programme, Yakshagana, a theatre form of Karnataka, which combines dance, music, dialogue, costume, make-up, and stage techniques with a unique style, will be performed here on Monday, Tuesday and March 28 and in Imphal on Friday and Saturday.

Plays Vaali Moksha, Gadha Yuddha and Seetapaharana will be staged here while Seetapaharana and Gadha Yuddha will be staged in Imphal, a release said.
