S. University of Baroda. She has had 36 solo shows and participated in a number of important group exhibitions across the world. She has participated in various Art Fairs including Art Singapore, ARCO (in Madrid, Spain), India Art Summit, Art Basel Hong Kong, India Art Fair etc. She has also been a part of many residencies and art projects at National and International levels. Ms. Rodwittiya has also worked as a Visiting and Guest Faculty at many prestigious Universities. Ms. Rekha Rodwittiya is the CEO of the Collective Studio Baroda.



Dr. Gayatri Menon, is a Senior Faculty at the National Institute of Design (NID), Ahmedabad, with more than 20 years of experience in design education, research and practice.
