About Exhibition:

The exhibition will present materials on the history of Africans, recounting the tale of the extraordinary achievements of Africans in India from 16th century onwards, where they became high ranking officials, generals, commanders and even rulers. The history of the Afro-Indian community called "siddis" in India who went on to rule two kingdoms along western coast of India, and the lineage of siddi royalty from "Slaves to Sultans". India presents the rare example in the world where people of African origin who were brought in as slaves, went on to rule an alien population. This exhibition revolves around those who were descended from the earlier arrivals from Bengal to Gujarat in the west and to the Deccan in Central India, these men and women known as siddi and habshis vigorously asserted themselves in the country of their enslavement. Besides appearing in written documents, the Africans have been immortalized in the rich paintings of different eras, states and styles that form an important component of Indian Culture. Because of their high positions, they were captured in vivid and exquisite portraits as principal subjects or in the vicinity of non-African rulers. As rulers, city planners and architects, the Africans have left an impressive historical and architectural legacy that attests to their determination, skills and intellectual, cultural and military and political savvy.

About Dr. S.K. Nanda IAS


