

A Brief Report of Book-Release Function

The Kalātattvakośa Vol. VII was formally released by Hon'ble Dr. (Smt.) Kapila Vatsyayan, Founder Member-Secretary of IGNCA in a grand function organized by Kalakosha Division, Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts, New Delhi at IGNCA Lecture Hall on 10.12.15. The programme was presided over by Dr. (Smt.) Kapila Vatsyayan and Prof. R.N. Mishra was the chief guest. Sh. Chinmaya R. Gharekhan, President, IGNCA Trust also graced the occasion.
