- Master's Degree in Social Sciences and Humanities, preferably in Archaeology from a recognised University/ Institution
- Well acquainted with archaeology
- General knowledge of traditional arts and crafts, performing arts of India and related areas

Work Profile:

Consultant will be the overall in charge of the project 'Riverine Culture in India' and will start the research and study of the cultural heritage of River Saraswati.
