## PREFACE.

A preface is scarcely needed to this fourth part of the Catalogue. The table of contents shows what coins are here described. They are such as could not well come in any of the three preceding parts. They are coins of a most miscellaneous description. They represent the odd things the collector meets with in the bázárs of the Panjáb. They are, however, far from being of small value. The coins of the old Mahárájas of Kashmir and Kángra form two most interesting series. Those of the Maliks of Sístán show that collectors as yet have not been fully aware of what may be obtained. The Coins of Nímroz, which is another name for Sístán, also show this. Nímroz is now a desert. In olden times it was densely inhabited as the ruined cities now found there bear witness. The Turkestan Coins here given might perhaps have been given along with the Sámáni Coins. The few Central Asian Coins in silver, are modern. The Miscellaneous Muḥammadan Silver Coins and the Unassigned Silver Coins are interesting, as are the Miscellaneous Old Copper Muḥammadan Coins.

The Beluchistán Copper Coins are modern and are here edited for the first time. After them come coins of Bhopál, Bhúj, Baroda, Chamba, Garhwál, Indore, Kashmir and Jummún, Mysore, Nepál, Kuch Bahár, Udayapúr and Navanagar, in all of which there is something of interest. They are all modern. The coins of Garhwál are here edited for the first time. These coins are found in large quantities all over Northern India; those bearing the name of Parduman Sháh are however, most abundant. The few rupees of Native States are just samples of what may be obtained in large quantities. The same remark applies to Copper Coins of Native States. Coins of Sirmúr, the capital of which is Náhan, are however, very rare. Miscellaneous Indian Copper Coins might have been increased to an indefinite extent. Of most of these nothing whatever is known: their publication may elicit some information.

Unassigned Bronze Indian Coins open out a field of enquiry that will be at once evident to the reader. General Sir Alexander Cunningham had a lot of these, but could give no information about them. We shall some day know all about them.

Miscellaneous Copper Asiatic Coins deal with a variety of places. The East India Company Coins offer nothing worthy of note. They were collected because of their legends. No. 32 was never circulated. It was a trial piece, as was the rupee No. 14.

Coins of South India are just odd specimens of old currencies from that part of the Empire. Such are the coins of Travancore and Ceylon. Danish Copper Coins and Dutch East Indian Coins deal with the currencies of Denmark and Holland in the East. Miscellaneous Asiatic Silver Coins explain themselves.

Autonomous Coins from Kábul, Pesháwur, the Deraját, Qandahár, Shikárpúr, Herát, Híşár, Bukhárá, Balkh, Ghaznih, Kirmán and Khwárizm show the necessity there was in these places for a copper coinage. They seem to resemble our English tokens.

The English Coins here given were all picked up in Northern India and the Panjáb. They show how an English currency has wandered all over India. Coins from Russia, Turkey and European countries nearer to India than England, are shown both in silver and copper. Miscellaneous Copper Coins include things from many countries. American Coins have got some strange things in them.

The "Medals" are of some interest and so are the "Religious Medals," and the "Tickets" and "Weights." The "Copper Tokens" must have come here just in the same manner as the English Coins. There are some strange things in the "Advertisements" which could never have passed as Coins, though in the form of some copper currencies.

I suppose it was the sight of these many varieties of things made me secure them just in order that my collection might illustrate what is found in an Indian bázár. It will be seen that the coins are arranged under more than fifty headings, and that some of these are subdivided. In this part of the Catalogue therefore, Miscellaneous Coins are dealt with. Some of the groups are edited here for the first time, *e.g.*, the Nimroz Coins, pp. 18-20, the Beluchistán Coins, pp. 33-36, the Autonomous Coins of Kábul, Pesháwur, Qandahár, Herát, &c. All these coins are at any rate of historical value, no matter how little value they may have artistically. The whole of the coins described, excepting the "Weights," "Tickets," "Advertisements" and "Card markers," were once in circulation, and were therefore worth collecting and describing.

In bringing this Catalogue to a close I own, I must confess, that I did not know when I sold my collection, that its contents were quite so varied or so valuable. I had gone on collecting and collecting till I had forgotten, to some extent, what I had gathered together. It was only when everything had to be described that I became aware of what a strange medley of things I had accumulated.

It must not be supposed that this collection represents all the possibilities of Panjáb bázárs. With money, even now, superb coins may be obtained of the Græco-Bactrians, the Indo-Scythians, the Sultans of Ghazni and of Dehli, and of the Mogul Emperors. I was handicapped all the time by lack of money. I had to allow precious things to slip through my hands, or I purchased them to sell them in order to obtain funds for my Mogul series. In this way, however, many collections have been gainers. Many of the rarest coins in the British Museum Collection of Mogul Coins were found by me and parted with to General Cunningham. The rupee of Humáyún, B. M. Cat. No. 11, p. 9, was bought by me in Saharanpur; the rupee of Sháhjahán with name *Khurram*, I got in Lahore, B. M. Cat. No. 578, p. 114, and Sháh Shujá, Muḥammadí, B. M. Cat. No. 690, p. 135, was obtained in Dehli. Again I parted with several series years before I sold the mass of my collection. Thus my Sikh Coins I sold to the Lahore Museum, my Súri Rupees went to Madras. My Square Silver Kashmir Coins were purchased by the British Museum as were my coins of Aḥmad Sháh Durrání and of Nádir Sháh, struck in India. Many rare coins I obtained, went to private collectors. I never, however, allowed a Mogul Coin that would really help me to complete a reign, to slip through my fingers. I always regretted letting the three go which I have mentioned above, but then the price offered me was too tempting.

Amritsar, was pleased to notice some of the results of my labours. But after all the chief pleasure I have is that, the coins I have collected and described will form the nucleus of a collection which will assist the students of the history of the Panjáb and adjacent countries. When the late William Marsden made over his collection of Oriental Coins to the British Museum, he could not see that each small group would grow into a complete collection. But if we compare the British Museum Catalogues of Oriental Coins with the coins in his book, we shall see that each portion of it has been indefinitely enlarged. More than this, no sooner were the Catalogues finished than two immense appendices of new coins were ready. By this time new editions of the whole must be necessary. It will be thus, I trust, in the Panjáb. The present collection will be indefinitely increased until it represent fully in coins, the whole of the history of that part of the world of which Lahore is centre.

## Note.

In number (10), the date 1138 must be, I think, intended for 1838. It is, however, plain 1138 on all the three coins. Were it 1138 H., that is equal to 1725 A.D., long before Parduman Sháh was born. In the same way, 1145, must be 1845. To both 1138 and 1145 we have the word سنبت, "Sambat." In No. (11), the 38 must be 1838. Nos. (13) and (14), have "Bahádur Malik Paltí," or "Paktí," on them. I can find no trace of such an individual. There was a Gurkha General, Bahádur Sháh, who struck coins at Náhan, in 1227 H. It is quite possible he was once in Srínagar. No. (15) may be a coin of Parakram Sháh, a brother of Parduman Sháh, and who was at one time in power. The mint "Srínagar" is most unmistakably on the whole of the coins, which must therefore belong to Garhwál, of which Srínagar was the capital.





The dates accord with no kings' names approaching the uncertain names on the coins. ربي I thought might be Ratan Sinha of Mewán. And راجا I felt inclined to attribute to Khumba, and بلرا to Bikrama or Vikrama; but nothing is certain except that the coins are a great puzzle. They are frequently met with. Sir Alexander Cunningham had a series of them. Since I sold my collection I have begun to collect a new series of these numismatic puzzles.





