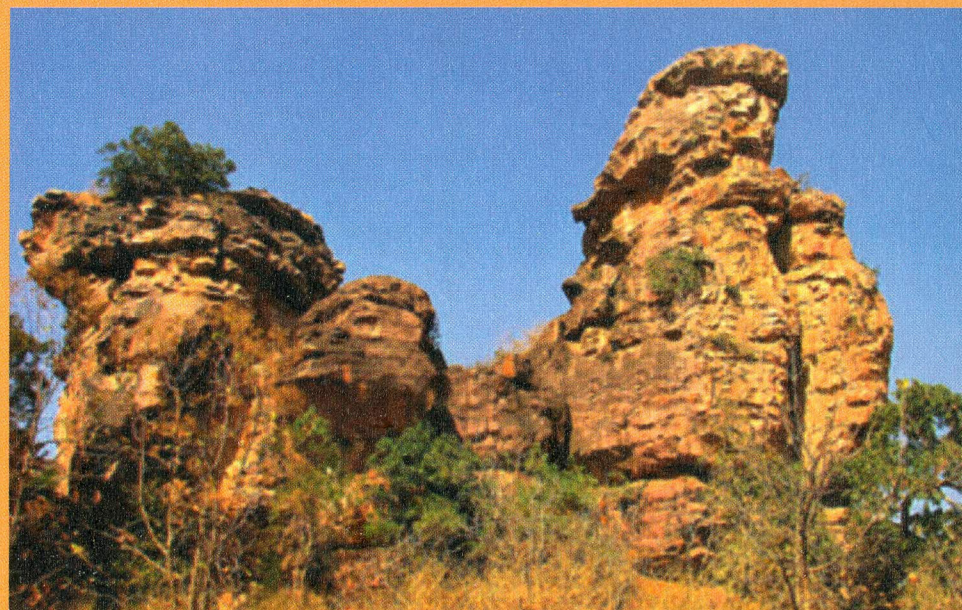

GLORIOUS BHIMBETKA A UNESCO World Heritage Site

Evidence of prehistoric art at Bhimbetka is as rich as the archaeological remains of man's habitation. It is situated in the foothills of Vindhyan Mountains in Raisen district of Madhya Pradesh and was discovered by Dr. V. S. Wakankar in 1957. The site was enlisted in the UNESCO World Heritage list in 2003. The word Bhimbetka was corrupted Hindi word from 'Bhimbaithka', meaning 'seat or seating place of Bhim'.
