Exteriors Decorated with architectural motifs like *pidhamundis* in

both talajangha and uparajangha of the jagamohana, talagarbhika in khakhara design flanked by naga-nagi pilasters in the vimana, khakharamundis at the base of the doorways of the jagamohana, dopichhasimhas and deulacharinis etc; decorative motifs such as- scroll work with or without animal motifs, miniature chaitya motifs, beaded border, jagrata motifs; divinities such as dikpalas and dikpalikas in the kanika pagas, secular motifs like - siksadana motifs, royal figures, warrior riding on the horse, *linga* worship, *navikas* in *tribhanga*
