Present	:	ABANDONED / IN USE : In use It is a living temple and the presiding deity is an eight armed Mahishamardini Durga. Iconographically the image can be dated to the 6 th -7 th century A.D. The deity is so named on account of its location on the <i>sikhara</i> (top) of the hillock. <i>Chandi</i> is another form of <i>Durga</i> . Hence it is known as <i>Sikhara Chandi</i> .
