ganthiala in between them and a shallow frontal porch which stands over a decorated *pista* of 1.16 mtrs high.

respectively.

Ornamentation

Exteriors : Decorated with architectural motifs like - khakhara

mundis & pidhamundis in lower & upper jangha respectively which enshrines Dikpalas & their consorts in kanika pagas. Royal figures - male or female sitting on a coach are predominated in both the mundis, nayikas, gaja-vidals & nara-vidalas in the junction of the pagas, mithuna & maithuna figures, linga worship

by a male & female devotees etc.
