Construction Technology | The rock-cut sculptural panel preserves an image of eight-armed Ganesa, of which the upper set of hands is seen stretching a serpent over his head. The proboscis plucks sweets from a modakapatra held in one of the left hands. The major right arm crosses the body in gajahasta holding a rosary while one of the left hands holds the kuthara. The remaining right hands hold a broken tusk and probably another kuthara. He is accompanied by a small mouse depicted on the left side beside his leg. N.A The rock-cut sculpture is in high relief. |
