of Visnu Trivikrama, Narasimha, Varaha on the walls of the *vimana* & *jagamohana*. The pillars of the processional path are decorated with Krisnalila scenes. *Nayika* figures are inserted as a bracket type on the *bada* and the recess between *pidhas* of the

vimana.
