Ornamentation

Exteriors : Decorated with architectural motifs such as khakharamundis and pidhamundis in the talajangha

khakharamundis and pidhamundis in the talajangha and uparajangha respectively of the vimana whereas khakharamundis are carved out in both lower & upper janga of the jagamohana. A miniature angasikhara surmounted by a gaja-kranta motif on the frontal raha of the vimana. Udyotasimhas are found on each raha. Dopichhasimhas and deulacharinis are over the beki to support the amala. The images inserted in the recess of the pagas are- Brahma, Visnu, Siva, Parvati, Indra, Krisna and Radha, Gopinatha, Kaliyadalana, nayikas like- Vinavadika, Alasakanyas, drumar, images of mithuna and maithuna etc. In the kanthi of the jagamohana khakharamundis alternate with

nayikas figures are carved out.

Interiors : Lotus design in the ceiling of the jagamohana, the

stucco figure of the builder and dopichhasimhas are

also noticed on the wall of the jagamohana.
