Exteriors : The temple is decorated with architectural motifs like –

khakharamundis, pidhamundis and minature rekha mundis in talajangha, uparajangha and above the veranda respectively. The recess between the pagas represented with vidals, erotics, amorous couple and various nayika figures. The raha projections of the jagamohana carved with Krisnalila scenes, dancing nayikas, and sikshadana motifs. Gajakranta motifs are found in each raha, dopichhasimhas and deulacharinis

over the beki of the vimana

Interiors : The doorjambs of the *jagamohana* has 3 fold floral

mouldings with Gaja-Laxmi in the lintel.
