Exteriors : The exterior of the *vimana* is plain, the *jagamohana* is

decorated with non-functional braket figures in the bada & Gandi junction and the Garuadamandapa is decorated with architectural motifs such as Khakharamundi & pidhamundi niches housed with the

images of divinites, nayika, erotics etc.

Interiors : The interior of the temple is plain except the six niches

in the inner wall of the *vimana*, which housed with the images of Tara, Dhyani-Buddha and an image of

Avalokatesvara.

jagamohana & Garudamandapa are late Orissan style with fivefold division of bada with unusual vertical

projection.
