Exteriors

: The frontal wall of the temple is decorated with five anga- sikharas on the gandi including two on the sides and projecting lions each on the raha. The talajangha and uparajangha adorned with khakharamundis and pidhamundis respectively. A khakharamundi up to its gandi portion is designed in the talagarbhika and the mastaka of the same is formed in the urdhagarbhika.

The doorjambs have three sakhas and Saiva dvarapalas houses in the pidhamundi niches at the base.
