ARCHITECTURAL STYLE

Exteriors : Decorated with architectural motifs like *khakharamundis* and *pidhamundis* in the lower and upper *jangha* respectively of both the *vimana* and *jagamohana*; balustrade window on the northern & southern side of the *jagamohana*; projecting lion on each *raha* and *deulacharinis* over the *beki* to support the *amla*.
