ARCHITECTURAL STYLE

- **Ornamentation**
Exteriors : The exterior of the temple is decorated with various sculptural motifs like *nayikas*, erotics, divine and semi divine gods and goddesses, royal figures, saints and various architectural motifs like *naga-nagi* pilasters, *kirtimukha*, elongated *khakharamundi* and scroll works.
