The face of the well is marked by 2 Pillars/columns attached to a building and 2 more independent pillars. The two independent pillars have octagonal shafts with a floral umbrella/chhatris on top. The sqare mouth of the wall is covered with a metal grill and above it is a stone railing connecting the pillars and supporting a windless. The cylindrical shift of the well is lived with bricks and plaster. There is a shrine in a modern constructed building next to the well on the platform.
