This chattri has a 'mukh-mandap' like portico followed by the adjoining main chattri. Over both the structures there are bulbous domes with profusely carving. The pinnacle of the dome is in shape of a flowered lotus. From inside the dome is a	

corbelled stone slabs with a medallion in the centre. In this chattri there is a 'Chaumukhishivaling' along with a "Nandi" and a stone slab with carving of men and women worshiping Shivlinga.
