Note: This gate is a composition of the pillars and a lintel supported by them. The architraves have chakra patterns with "basantpatika" kirtimukh on the friezes. The pillar capitals are plain and simple. The pillars are ornate with floral and geometrical pattern. The most important part is the free standing triangular arch formation.
