Abstract of the lecture

Bharat has been an economic superpower for many centuries in its ancient past. It's history of economic trade, illustrious monuments and sophisticated way of living has been well documented. Did all of this happen by any chance? Or was there a coherent and logical economic framework behind it? My research for the past decade argues that for centuries Dharma based economic frameworks have played a central part in policymaking. Given that the 'way of life' continues till date, their relevance remains an important research objective that needs to be discussed and debated. This lecture would provide an overview of Dharma based economic frameworks, lay its core components and highlight its relevance to todays Bharat in enhancing effectiveness of policy outcomes.

Sriram Balasubramanian is a reputed Economist and Author whose key areas of interest include global macroeconomics, economic trends in emerging markets, new growth models, Indic/Dharmic culture & an innate passion for India's socio-economic happenings.
