Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), New Delhi and the APSARA National Authority, Siem Reap (Cambodia), signed an MOU in 2017, to study the common threads of art and culture with Cambodia in particular and South East Asian countries, in general. IGNCA has built a vast resources of study materials in the form of books, monographs, visuals etc. for further research. So far, we have published over two dozen books and numerous research projects. In pursuance with this MOU, IGNCA is organizing a three-days International Conference titled “Angkor Wat: The Monument and the Living Presence” in the last week of March 2018.

The proposed conference will attempt a holistic interpretation of the world famous monument both in time and space. Tracing the journey of Khmer civilization, locating ourselves at the majestic west gate of the monument, the conference also recapitulate long-standing India-Cambodia friendship. Prospective papers present Angkor Wat as centre piece and looking at the evolution of Angkor civilization in retrospect and prospect. It is expected that the output of the conference will carve out a Roadmap for collaborative projects during next five years and documentation of the Angkor Wat for a multimedia presentation.
