Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA) will be celebrating 5th Nadi Utsav from 19th to 21st September, 2024 at IGNCA, Janpath, New Delhi. The Nadi Utsav is an annual programme of IGNCA dedicated to the rivers and riverine cultures. Several rivers along with their tributaries flow across the Indian land and have undeniable geographical, historical, mythological, and spiritual significance. These rivers have nurtured generations with abundance, prosperity, and also been the source of numerous lives and livelihoods in surrounding areas. - Short documentary (Duration: 15 30 minutes)
- Documentary (Duration: 40 60 minutes)
