

## Shri Devendra Swarup (1926 - 2019)

Shri Devendra Swarup was born on 30th March 1926 in small town of Kanth (Moradabad), Uttar Pradesh. A born nationalist, Prof. Swarup participated in Indian freedom movement from his school days. From his college days he got associated with RSS and

got motivated by nationalistic thinkers and working for RSS. He obtained MA in Ancient Indian History and a PhD from University of Lucknow.

Shri Devendra Swarup's journey in journalism started in 1948 from Hindi magazine Chetna published from Banaras as its Associate Editor. He served as the Editor of Panchajanya for a long time, former director of the project named 'Documentation on British Census Policy', former director and vice president of Deendayal Research Institute. In 2019, the *Padma Shri*, was posthumously awarded to Shri Devendra Swarup. He has written over fifteen books, many research papers and articles on subject as varied as Education to History, Politics to International Affairs.

Shri Devendra Swarup donated his personal collection to the IGNCA Kala Nidhi Reference Library in 2018. The collection consisting of 8,500 books and scholarly periodicals comprises of books on history, religion, sociology, literature and biographies.


In honor of his lasting legacy, IGNCA initiated the Devendra Swarup Memorial Lecture in 2019. Distinguished individuals such as Shri Suresh Soni, Shri Banwari, Prof. Heeraman Tiwari and Prof. Murali Manohar Joshi have since delivered these lectures.

## About the Speaker

**Dr. J. K. Bajaj** is presently Director, Centre for Policy Studies and former Chairman of the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi. His area of interests includes; history, sociology, economy and polity of India. He along with Prof. M. D. Srinivas, has published a major work on Mahatma Gandhi, covering the period up to 1914, entitled: "Making of a Hindu Patriot: The Background of Gandhiji's Hind Swaraj". His two of other best known works are: Firstly, The Religious Demography of India, a comprehensive compilation of the complete data on the changing religious profile of India up to the district level for the whole census period from 1871 onwards. Secondly, Annam Bahu Kurvita: Indian Discipline of Growing and Sharing Food in Plenty, which describes the classical Indian polity based on classical texts of Indian Civilization. He has also compiled and edited a series of Resource Atlases of several districts of Madhya Pradesh.
