IGNCA is a repository of academic resources in the form of books, photographs, audi-visual material and digital format for the study of 'The Arts,' the term understood in all its connotations. The area of IGNCA's mandate includes the oral, aural, the written, and the narrative traditions of India, the fairs and festivals, the lifestyles of communities, the classic and the contemporary, the traditional and the folk cultures of this vast nation.

IGNCA marks its Founding Day over two days, with lectures, concerts, an exhibition and film screenings.

Release of Publications

IGNCA in-house newsletter Vihangama will be re-launched. Several publications - books and DVDs will be released.
