Request for Proposal for Rajya Sabha Lobby Wall Bhakti Traditions of India in the New Parliament Building

The Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts, is visualised as a centre encompassing the study and experience of all the arts forms with its own integrity. It partakes of the holistic worldview articulated throughout Indian tradition. The arts are understood here to comprise the fields of creative and critical literature, written and oral; the visual arts, ranging from architecture, sculpture, painting and graphics to general material culture, photography and film; the performing arts of music, dance and theatre in their broadest connotation; and all else in fairs, festivals and lifestyle that has an artistic dimension. The IGNCA seeks to place the arts within the context of the natural and human environment.

IGNCA has been entrusted with various art works installations of the New Parliament Building, which is under construction in New Delhi. Once completed, it will be the seat of the Parliament of India. Accordingly, IGNCA is inviting Request for Proposal from reputed artists/agencies for conceptualizing, designing and creating art works. The art works are suggested to be anchored in Indian ethos. The proposal is requested for **Rajya Sabha Lobby Wall Bhakti Traditions of India in the New Parliament Building** at New Delhi. Interested bidders who have requisite experience of handling such art work with multiple artists may submit the proposal for the above work.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS

IGNCA would be detailing the minimum pre-qualification requirements and the process of selection by the RFP.

- The designated Committee constituted for the purpose by IGNCA would evaluate the eligibility of Bidders on the criteria mentioned in this RFP

based on their proposals. The eligible bidders would be called to present a PPT before the designated Committee at IGNCA, New Delhi.

- The bidders shall submit their offers strictly in accordance with the Terms & Conditions of this RFP document. Any bid that stipulates conditions contrary to the conditions given in the RFP document will be disqualified.
- Pre-bid queries: All queries regarding the RFP can be emailed to IGNCA on directoradmn.ignca@gmail.com till **17th January, 2023 by 5:00 PM**
- The bids should be submitted online on the CPP portal latest by **11.00 A.M.** on **30.01.2023**. The technical bids will be opened on **01.02.2023 at 11.00 A.M.**
- The technical presentation will be held on **03.02.2023 at 3.00 p.m.**
- The bidder should upload all documents with proper indexing and pagination.
- The bidder shall have to submit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 30,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty lakh only) in the form of Demand Draft of any scheduled Bank in favour of “IGNCA, New Delhi”. The scanned copy of the draft may be uploaded along with the Technical Bid forms. The original Demand Draft shall be submitted before opening of the Technical Bids.
- The bidders registered with MSME will be exempted from submission of EMD. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after finalization of the successful bidder and award of the work. EMD of the successful bidder shall be returned immediately after receipt of Performance Security Deposit. No interest shall be paid on EMD in any case. In the event of non-accepting the contract by the successful bidder by the stipulated date, the deposited amount towards EMD shall be forfeited.
- The successful bidder will have to deposit Performance Security equal to 3% of the value of the work either by way of Demand Draft or Bank Guarantee in favour of “IGNCA, New Delhi” as interest free security deposit for ensuring good performance within 15 days after acceptance of the contract. The performance security deposit shall be released after two months of successful completion of the contract. In case of any violation

of contract during the contractual period, the security deposit will be liable to be forfeited. No interest shall be paid on security deposit in any case.

- The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid.
- The bidders may carefully read the RFP document and accordingly submit the requisite information along with documents. Incomplete bids or bid not on the prescribed proforma (attached) without requisite details/EMD will be summarily rejected.
- IGNCA also reserves the sole right for carrying out amendments/modification/changes including any addendum to this RFP. Such amendments/modification/changes including any addendum to this RFP shall be notified on the IGNCA website www.ignca.gov.in and CPP portal and these will be binding on the artists / agencies.
- IGNCA reserves the right to accept/reject any bid before the award of work. IGNCA also reserves the right to re-issue the RFP at any stage before awarding the work and overrule the objection of bidders. IGNCA also reserves the rights to extend the validity period.
- IGNCA reserves the right to extend the deadline without assigning any reasons thereof. Intimation of the same shall be notified on the IGNCA website www.ignca.gov.in and on the eprocare.gov.in.
- The Technical bid will be opened on date, time and venue specified above in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representative who may wish to be present. The technical presentation will be held on the date and time mentioned in the RFP. In case of exigency, it can be held on later date and time under intimation to the concerned bidders.
- The financial bids of the only technically qualified bidders will be opened on the date and time which will be communicated to the technically qualified bidders separately.
- IGNCA will be free to award whole or part of the work to one or more qualified bidders.

- In case of deviation in quantum of work, the payment will be made on proportionate basis.

Timeline

In view of the project being of national importance, the work has compelling timelines. The timeline is 90 days from the date of award of the work. The delay in satisfactory completion of work attract penalty as mentioned in the RFP document.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

IGNCA shall evaluate the capabilities of the bidders (artists/agencies) based on their profile also keeping in view of the following criteria.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- a) A Bidder can be an individual artist/ company/ partnership firm/other legal entity incorporated or established as per the applicable laws in India.
- b) A consortium/joint venture of entities shall be allowed to bid and shall be considered for evaluation under this RFP. Preference will be given to the consortium /joint venture of entities/ company/ partnership firm/other legal entity incorporated or established as per the applicable laws in India, having at least one qualified artist, as one of the directors/proprietors/partners.

For Artist-

- a) The Artist should have the experience of at least 10 years in the field of art either as professional or is working in the industry. They should submit their experience proof through experience certificate from Government or reputed Educational institutions/Industry/ Newspaper Cuttings/ or Exhibition Catalogues.
- b) The artists should also submit the details regarding Exhibitions/ Art work/ Art Gallery projects and other similar works for any Organization in last 5 years. At least 03 (three) exhibits/ art works will be desirable.

c) The artists should also submit the last 3 years IT returns viz. FY 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22.

For Other Bidders-

a) The bidding agency must be in operation in India at least for past 5 (five) years in the same line of business. As proof, the agency may submit copy of Invoices/work orders/agreement copies/Purchase Order of any assignment executed in the last 5 years.

b) The agencies should also submit the details regarding Exhibitions/ Art work/ Art Gallery projects and other similar works for any Organization in last 5 years. At least 03 (three) exhibits/ art works will be desirable.

c) The agency must have attained annual turnover of Rs. 50 lakh in any of the last three financial years 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 from the same line of business. A certificate from practicing CA in this regard must be submitted as proof along with audited Balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account

d) The net worth of the bidder, as on 31.03.2022 should be positive.

Bidder must have attained minimum 60 marks to become technically eligible.

Terms and Conditions of the Contract:

- 1) The rates quoted by the successful bidder shall remain applicable till completion of the work without any escalation of the rates what so ever the reason.
- 2) The rates quoted by the bidders shall be valid for 60 days for acceptance of the IGNCA from the date of opening of Financial Bid.
- 3) The bidders who shall qualify in the Technical Bid will only be considered for opening of Financial Bid.
- 4) Canvassing in any form will be viewed seriously and, if any bidder is found to be resorting to such practices, the bid of such bidder will be rejected.
- 5)The bidder shall have to confirm the terms and conditions and other requirements of the RFP by signing all the required documents.
- 6) Time schedule for the completion of the work should be strictly adhered to by the bidder. If work is not completed according to the specifications mentioned in the RFP, within the stipulated period, penalty will be imposed @ 2% of the value of work for every week or part of week subject to maximum 10% of the value of the work.
- 7) In case of any abnormal irregularity noticed in the work, the maximum penalty up to 10% of the value of work can be levied by the IGNCA, which will be final and binding on the firm.
- 8) The Performance Security Deposit will be liable to be forfeited/ adjusted, if the successful bidder fails to execute the work in time/complete the work satisfactorily.
- 9) The IGNCA reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reasons and also forfeit part or whole of the performance security deposit, if the bidder fails to comply with the provisions of the RFP or complete the work satisfactorily within the schedule provided to the bidder.

10) In case, the successful bidder fails to complete the assigned job in part or in whole as the case may be, the contract of the bidder shall be cancelled and the assigned job will be got carried out from open market at the risk and cost of the bidder by the IGNCA and the penalty as deemed fit shall be imposed on the bidder or the excess amount if any involved towards completion of the work shall be charged from the bidder by the IGNCA.

11) The IGNCA reserves the right to accept fully or partially or reject any/all bids without assigning any reason(s) whatsoever. Bids not on the prescribed proforma, without requisite details, without EMD, bids received after the closing date & time and conditional bids will be rejected summarily.

12) In case of any dispute arising out in relation between the parties, the matter will be referred to the Arbitrator appointed by the IGNCA whose decision will be final and binding on both the parties.

13) Any dispute arising out in relation between the parties, will be subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi Courts only.

14) Any dispute between the agency and its employees / artists will be resolved by the agency itself without involvement of the IGNCA in any manner.

15) Payment:

(i) The payment will be made on receipt of bill in duplicate on a printed bill form indicating PAN of the artist/ agency. In case of agency, the GST number of agency and IGNCA may also be mentioned on the bill. The bill should be certified by the Chartered Accountant. A completion certificate of the work may be enclosed with the bill.

(ii) No advance will be given to the bidder for executing the work without bank guarantee of the matching amount.

(iii) Counter conditions by the bidders in matters concerning payment of bills shall not be acceptable.

(iv) Tax deduction at Source (TDS) and other applicable taxes will be deducted from each bill by IGNCA.

Other Terms and Conditions

1. All Intellectual property rights of the provided / installed Art work shall be vested with the IGNCA / Ministry of Culture, Government of India. The IGNCA / Ministry of Culture, Government of India will be free to

utilise the art work in any form and second party will have no claim that includes the right of reproduction on the art work provided under this contract. There will be no responsibility of the IGNCA / Ministry of Culture, Government of India for any dispute in this regard.

2. The artistic work should be original and legally authenticated, failing which the bidder will be responsible for consequences including civil / criminal liabilities arising out of it.
3. IGNCA will have no direct relationship with artists / craftsmen engaged by the bidder, nor any liability or responsibility towards them.
4. The bidder should provide detailed explanation of the originality, relevance, significance and meaning of each artistic work.
5. The bidder will be responsible for the warrantee of the originality of the work. The bidder should ensure that provided artistic work is original and not the copy of any other artistic work.
6. The bidder must protect the tribal rights, the community rights and indigenous artistic rights of the artists.
7. No name / Signature / logo /credit of the artist / second party will be visible on the artistic work.
8. It should be ensured that integration of people and culture without any discrimination should be reflected in the artistic work and it may show the inclusiveness of integration of Indian culture.
9. The IGNCA will have the power to reject any art work at any stage which is against the national interest and national integrity etc.
10. The chain custody of the artistic work should be clear and transparent and IGNCA will not be held responsible for any dispute.

Price Schedule:

The bidder must quote the lowest rates in the prescribed proforma of Financial Bid only appended at FORM -IV. The bids will be evaluated on Quality and Cost Based Selection method (QCBS) basis as per GFR with 70% weightage on technical score and 30% weightage on financial score.

The bidder with the highest composite score will be declared as the successful bidder. In case of tie in the highest composite score of multiple bidders, the bidder with higher technical score will be declared as the successful bidder.

Note: Technical marks are the marks scored by the bidder in the technical bid as mentioned in the evaluation table in the section **Technical Proposal and Presentation** above.

Award of Work

The IGNCA will award the work to the successful bidder. The successful bidder needs to enter in a separate agreement with IGNCA on award of the work.

Annexure I

Request for Proposal for Rajya Sabha Lobby Wall Bhakti Traditions of India in the New Parliament Building

Scope of Work

A wall in the New Parliament building will show the Bhakti Traditions of India. The Bhakti Parampara has been significant religious and spiritual movement in medieval India. It brought social reforms to all sections of society cutting cross all the boundaries. The method of devotion to achieve salvation was emphasized by the saints of the Bhakti tradition. The intellectual-spiritual tradition of India introduced a movement that advocated for integrity, unity, duty, equality, respectful life, and so on. It originated during the Early Medieval period and spread gradually to the whole subcontinent through the poems and teachings of various Saints and thinkers till modern era. Whole content that is to be designed on the wall would be approved by IGNCA and the vendor may need to amend as per the requirements. This research is subject to vetting by IGNCA. Following stages of conceptualization are to be followed in order to develop the creative representation of the theme:

1. Research: The first step of the project will involve conducting research on the India's association with Bhakti. This research will provide the basis for the content creation and visualization stages of the project.
2. Content Creation: Based on the research conducted, the next step will involve creating the content for the art installation. This will involve developing a narrative for the installation that showcases the Bhakti traditions of India in an engaging and informative way.
3. Ideation and Visualization: The third step of the project will involve creating visualizations of the content created in the previous step. This

may include creating sketches, designs, storyboard, or other visual representations of the planned art installation.

4. Execution: Once the content and visualizations are approved and finalized, the next step will involve executing the art installation. This will involve creating the actual artworks and installing them on the 44.5m x 3.15m wall in the new parliament building.
5. Installation: The fifth step of the project will involve installing the artworks on the wall in the parliament building. This will involve coordinating with the building's staff to ensure that the installation is completed safely and efficiently. All Fixations, Alterations and Amendments must be adhered to as per the requirements.
6. Method and Material: The art installation may be created using a variety of materials, including paints, canvases, and other art supplies. It would be preferred if multimedia practices are indulged in the making of the work. The specific materials used will be determined based on the requirements of the project and the preferences of the artist.
