Expression of Interest for Art work installation (Guardian Statues) at Ceremonial Entrances and Public Entrances in the New Parliament Building

The Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts, is visualised as a centre encompassing the study and experience of all the arts forms with its own integrity. It partakes of the holistic worldview articulated throughout Indian tradition. The arts are understood here to comprise the fields of creative and critical literature, written and oral; the visual arts, ranging from architecture, sculpture, painting and graphics to general material culture, photography and film; the performing arts of music, dance and theatre in their broadest connotation; and all else in fairs, festivals and lifestyle that has an artistic dimension. The IGNCA seeks to place the arts within the context of the natural and human environment.

IGNCA has been entrusted with various art works installations of the New Parliament Building, which is under construction in New Delhi. Once completed, it will be the seat of the Parliament of India. Accordingly, IGNCA is inviting Expression of Interest from reputed agencies for conceptualizing, designing and creating art works. The art works are suggested to be anchored in Indian ethos. The proposal is requested for art installation(Guardian Statues) at Ceremonial Entrances and Public Entrances of New Parliament Building at New Delhi. Interested bidders who have experience of handling art work of multiple artists may submit the EOI for the above work.

PROCESS OF SELECTION

IGNCA would be detailing the minimum pre-qualification requirements and the process of selection in the EOI

- The designated Committee would evaluate the quality / capability of Bidders on the criteria mentioned in the EOI based on their proposals received and fulfilment of eligibility criteria. The eligible agencies would be called to make a presentation before a designated Committee at IGNCA, New Delhi.
- The bidders shall submit their offers strictly in accordance with the Terms & Conditions of the EOI document. Any bid that stipulates conditions contrary to the conditions given in the EOI document stands disqualified.
- The EOI should be submitted online on the CPP portal latest by **5.00 P.M.** on **18.07.2022** and the EOIs will be opened on **20.07.2022 at 3.00 P.M.**

Scope of Work

Scope of work for the agency shall be as given below-

Type and Choice of Guardian Statues- The Parliament is the citadel of the collective aspirations of the people of a country. Planning to install the guardian statues as part of art work involves gathering together the dreams of the people of India over the centuries, as understood through literary, iconographical and artistic expressions. Following are the ideas behind the vision to have guardian statues at the 6 entrances of the new parliament building at New Delhi-

- It augurs well with the rich heritage of Indian culture
- Is symbolic of the people's aspirations,
- Is rooted in the country's ethos
- Manifests inclusiveness
- To select existing examples for the guardian statues so that element of our rich history may be appreciated.
- To be taken as ornamentation or Alankaran which will be embodiment of our shared cultural heritage.
- To capture the spirit of the Constitution of India which is all about equality, equity and harmony.
- Exact replica of proposed animals may be taken from the heritage sites of India.

The animals that are under consideration are GAJA, ASVA, GARUDA, MAKARA, SHARDULA VYALA and HAMSA.

Medium and Sculpting- The medium that has to be chosen for the construction of the statues is White Sandstone, and, the weight is proposed to be up to 4 tons with height of 5-7 feet. The statues will be hand sculpted.

Final decision on the choices of Guardian Statues will be taken by the highpower Committees of Ministry of Culture and IGNC (Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts).

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

IGNCA shall evaluate the capabilities of the bidders based on their profile and

also keeping in view of the following criteria. Agencies not fulfilling the below criteria need not apply.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

a) A Bidder can be a company/ partnership firm/other legal entity incorporated/established as per the applicable laws in India. A consortium/Joint venture of entities shall be allowed to bid and shall be considered for evaluation under this EOI.

b) The agency must be in operation in India at least from past 5 (five) years in the sameline of business. As proof the agency may submit copy of Invoices/work orders/agreement copies/Purchase Order of any assignment executed in the last 5 (five) years before the EOI due date.

c) The agency must have executed at least 03 (three) Exhibitions/ dealing in Art work/ Art Gallery projects and other similar work for any Government Organization/ PSUs /Chambers of Industry Association in last three years.

d) The agency must have attained annual turnover of Rs. 50 lakh in any of the last three financial years 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 from the same line of business. A certificate from practising CA in this regard must be submitted as proof along with audited Balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account.

e) The net worth of the bidder, as on 31.03.2021 should be positive.

EOI Proposal

The agencies fulfilling the pre-qualification criteria will be asked to make a presentation before a committee constituted by the IGNCA for this purpose.

c. We have not directly or indirectly or through an agent engaged or indulged in any corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or

restrictive practice, as defined in the EOI document, in respect of any tender or request for proposal issued by or any agreement entered into with the IGNCA or any other public sector enterprise or any government, Central or State; and

d. We hereby certify that we have taken steps to ensure that in conformity with the

We understand that except to the extent as expressly set forth in the Agreement, we shall have no claim, right or title arising out of any documents or information provided to us by the IGNCA or in respect of any matter arising out of or concerning or relating to the Bidding Process including the award of Concession.
