

Edaneer Madham at Kasarcode keeps the Sanyasa tradition of the Vadakke Madham and Munchira Madham is the branch of Thrukkaikkat Madham. Eminent Advaitha Scholars were the residents of Thrissur Madhams. These Madhams have made remarkable contributions in the field of Veda and Vedanta. But now a days, even the people close to Thrissur are not at all aware of the Madhams and the contributions made to Sanskrit Literature.
